



- Difficulties faced by the students regarding course decisions and career choice.








SELF ASSESSMENT



Self Assessment is conducted by QEC for the purpose of improving students' learning, and evaluating whether academic and learning standards are being met




FEEDBACK FORMS



Establishment


Industrial Liaison Office (ILO) at Indus University was established in 2010


ESTABLISHMENT OF ILO

- To hold job/ career fairs for the job placement of students in well renowned organization.




