**To establish student support services, as it plays an important role in promoting successful outcomes for small tier universities.**

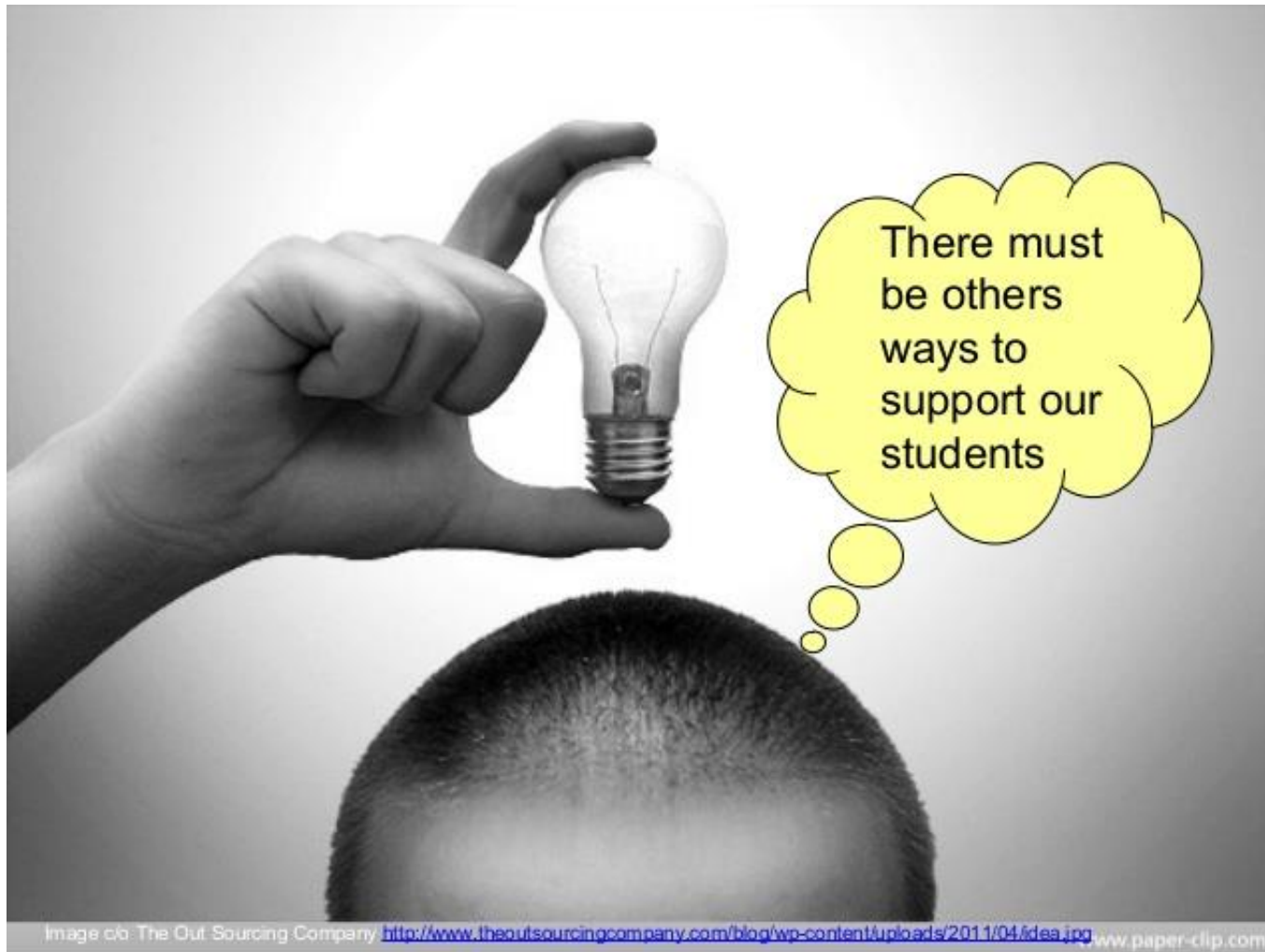

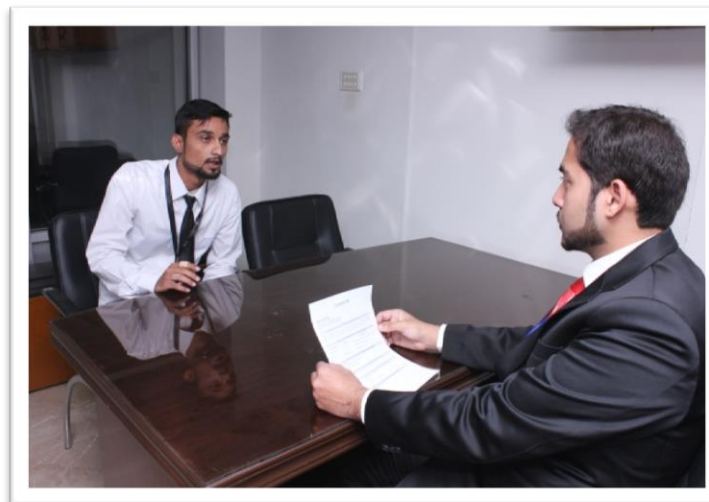

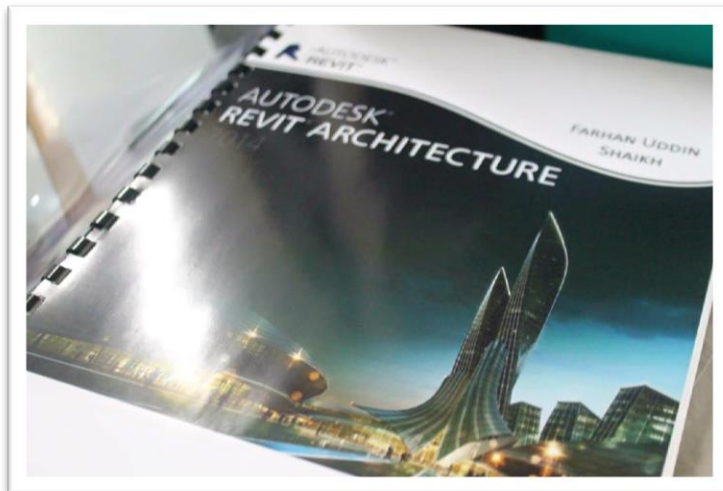
