## **HE AI Policies**



Policies should be carefully developed and implemented with the collaboration of all stakeholders. Serious problems with policies in many European HE institutions (e.g., Glendinning et al., 2022)

Policy deficiencies can be a threat to the realisation of Al and the quality of educational outcomes. Fundamental dimensions of policies: •detecting AI breaches, •reacting to

unacceptable academic conduct, and

promoting academic integrity values.

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Many policies focus on the detection and reaction dimensions.

Student conduct can be influenced sustainably:

 by raising the awareness level of all stakeholders in HE institutions. The most frequent type of Al breach in HE is plagiarism, but contract cheating is a growing threat.

Policies should prioritise education and deterrence, for creating and maintaining a sustainable culture of AI.
